

Q. What Form do I use when using a substitute or adding a new player to my team?

A. There are 2 member forms typically called the ‘short form’ which is the ‘membership application’ and the long form which is called the ‘Established Player Eligibility form’. The bottom of the long form also contains a members application.

1. All players are required at the beginning of the season to submit a membership application during their first week of play (short form). This requirement is found under VII) Team Requirements on page 12 of the rules of play.

Once the season starts (IE the first week of play) the divisions with their quality parameters have been set so the V) Players Defined section of the rules of play starting on Page 9 apply when determining which form to use.

2. When adding a new member or substitute, the first thing you do is determine if the player is already established.

Established players will be on the Established Player list provided during captain orientation and can also be found on the website. It has the Extended Average Quality for those players that are established in the last 2 seasons of play. If they are not in the Established Player list for the current season, than they are considered non-established.

Non-Established Player

If the player as is not established, a members application (short form) is required. These players will be subject to over parameter penalties as described in V) Players Defined 2) Non-Established Players on page 10.

Established Players

If the new member or substitute is established, then an eligibility work sheet (long form) is required. An eligibility work sheet is required to determine if the new member or substitute is eligible to play on your team. If the player is not eligible, the team will be penalized as described in V) Players Defined 1) pages 9 and 10

Note: A separate member’s form is required for each player each night even if the substitute was used previously by you or a different team previously.
